New groups shall be placed on the roll call at their second A.S.C. and shall have voting privileges upon answering in the 1st roll call of their third A.S.C.

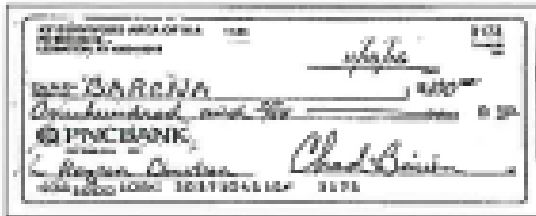

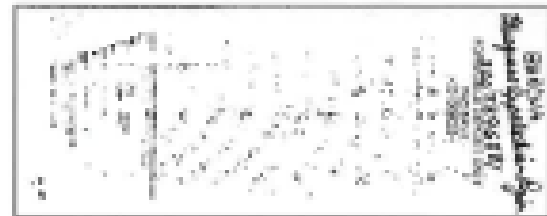

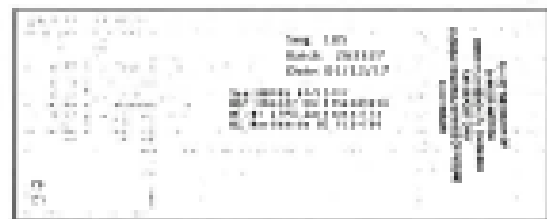
